In the long run, it will help enhance the overall quality and competitiveness of the local workforce.

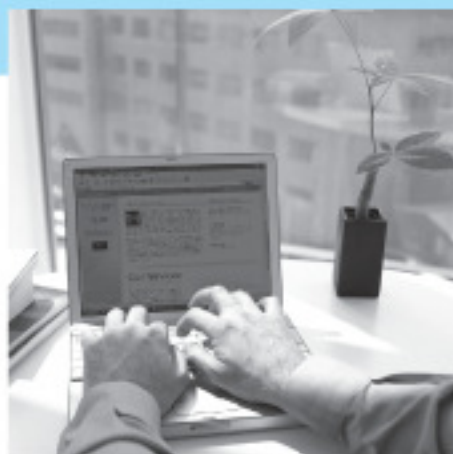
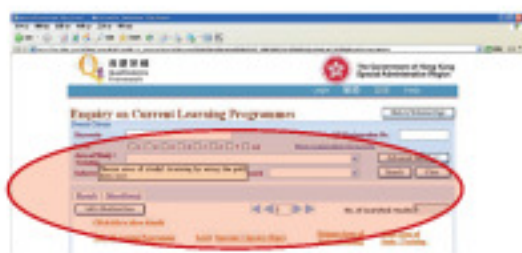

Qualifications Register (QR)

- A free on-line database of qualifications for reference of the general public.
- Provides information on various education and training programmes, qualifications and their course providers.
- Provides various enquiry options (e.g. search by “area of study/training”, “industry”, etc.) for quick retrieval of the most up-to-date information on QF-recognised qualifications.
- All qualifications registered on the QR are quality-assured and recognised under the Qualifications Framework (QF).

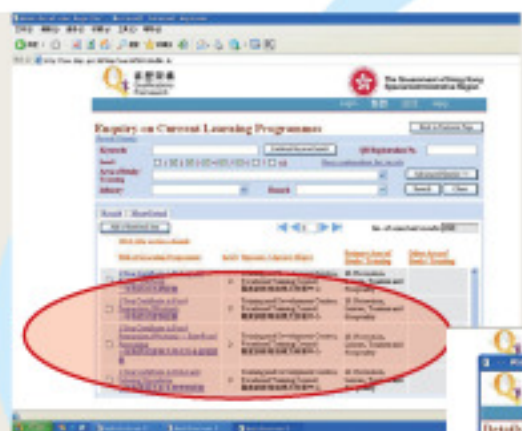
On-line Database for recognised qualifications

The Hong Kong Council for Accreditation of Academic and Vocational Qualifications (HKCAAVQ) is empowered to be the Accreditation Authority and Qualifications Register Authority for the quality assurance of qualifications (except those awarded by self-accrediting institutions) to underpin the QF and for administering the QR. All programmes that are uploaded to the QR are quality-assured and recognised under the QF.
