Knowledge in the subject area Be able to • use the ability to identify approved inspection reference standards (e.g. material samples and product samples) and their role in quality inspections • state the impact of identifying material and product technical specifications (e.g. material weight, product construction details, measurement points, tolerance requirements and colour requirements) on inspection methods and results • apply an understanding of customer quality specifications and inspection criteria relating to material and product inspections • recognise the content of relevant technical documents (e.g. drawings and specification documents) and their interrelationships 2. Application and process Be able to • obtain, verify and prepare appropriate inspection reference standards according to established procedures • verify the consistency between inspection reference standards and relevant technical documents (e.g. drawings and specification documents) • confirm that inspection reference standards have been correctly identified, labelled and are applicable to the relevant production batch • handle and store and protect inspection reference standard samples according to established procedures to maintain their condition for inspection purposes • organise and determine the applicable inspection requirements to support subsequent quality inspection activities

Exhibit professionalism Be able to • evaluate the completeness and suitability of inspection reference standards and inspection requirements before inspection to ensure that they are sufficient and suitable for actual inspection purposes • identify any specific inspection requirements that differ from standard inspection criteria and handle them appropriately • where inconsistencies or insufficient information are identified, consult relevant departments to ensure the accuracy of inspection preparations
