Competency	Performance Requirements 1. Knowledge in the subject area Be able to - state an understanding of the purpose of conducting corrective action follow up after completing quality inspections - state knowledge of the guidelines and handling procedures relating to corrective actions under established quality reports and quality control procedures - understand common types of corrective actions in material and product quality control (e.g. trimming excess threads, removing stains, and re-stitching loose or broken seams) - apply acceptance criteria and decide whether corrected materials or products meet the required acceptance criteria 2. Application and process Be able to - identify inspection cases that require corrective action follow up based on inspection results and relevant instructions - according to established acceptance criteria and original inspection requirements, inspect materials or products that have undergone corrective action or rework - verify whether corrective actions have been completed according to specified requirements - decide whether materials or products after corrective action or rework meet established acceptance criteria - record the status or results of corrective action follow up according to established quality documentation procedures and systems 3. Exhibit professionalism Be able to - conduct corrective action follow up objectively without affecting the original inspection results or decisions - when corrective actions have not been completed, or non-conformities still exist, handle the situation or report it according to established procedures
Assessment Criteria	The integrated outcome requirements of this UoC are the abilities to accomplish:

	• Identify cases requiring follow up based on inspection results and verify whether corrective actions have been completed as required. • After quality inspections, decide whether corrected products meet acceptance criteria according to established procedures, verify the implementation status of corrective actions, and complete the relevant follow up records.
