Title	Formulate customer relationship strategy

Range	This unit of competency is applicable to all sea freight, air freight and express operators. Practitioners should be capable to formulate a customer-oriented strategy for customer relationship to strengthen the relationship with customers and achieve a win-win result.

Competency	Performance Requirements - Knowledge of customer relationship - Understand the importance of establishing good relationship with customers - Understand the impact of establishing good relationship with customers on the business strategy of the company - Understand the freight service needs of existing and potential customers - Understand factors affecting customer's choice of freight operators - Understand company's resources and limitations - Understand the concept of business partner relationship - Master the tools for the analysis of the relationship between the customer and the company's business performance, such as the ABC analysis and the major customer group analysis - Master different channels to contact customers - Understand the need to formulate relationship strategy for respective customers - Understand causes of customer dissatisfaction and customer loss - Formulate customer relationship strategy - Classify customers according to the business strategy of the company, and customer's needs, characteristics and business turnover - Analyse the possibility of establishing good relationship with the customer and the advantages and disadvantages for both sides - Analyse customer's business direction and freight service needs, and formulate the customer relationship strategy accordingly - Communicate with the customer regularly and suggest tailor-made services accordingly - Set up customer service group to analyse and assess performance of the services provided to major customers - Compile reports and guidelines to illustrate the formulated customer relationship strategy to the sale department
Assessment Criteria	The integrated outcome requirements of this unit of competency are: - Capable to analyse the characteristics and service needs of the customer groups of the company; - Capable to suggest different effective channels to contact and communicate with customers; and - Capable to compile reports to illustrate the formulated customer relationship strategy.
