- Verify the staff registration and qualification
- Ensure that there is sufficient and suitable security equipment provided on site
- ◆ Check, issue, circulate and file security documents
- Ensure that the security staff are provided with sufficient training in cargo transport security
- Pay attention to any irregularities in cargo transport, such as omission, incorrect number of cargoes, etc.
- Examine and record container sealing devices and their code number
- Send cargo transport information provided by shippers to relevant customs departments or organizations
- Check security operation records and reports
- Compile reports on security service contractor's performance
