	<ul> <li>Understand the common types of goods, for example, general cargoes, chilled and frozen goods, liquid cargoes, bulk cargoes, DG and heavy and outsize goods.</li> <li>Understand the characteristics of various types of goods, packaging requirement and special arrangement for transportation</li> </ul>
	2. Investigate the cause of damage to goods
	<ul> <li>Capable to handle the following tasks:         <ul> <li>Collect related information on the damage, for example, lost reports and images.</li> <li>Collect related information on loading, transportation and storage from accident reports, for example, temperature records and receipts of goods.</li> <li>Conduct sample testing if necessary</li> <li>Investigate the cause of damaged/loss goods based on the available information</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	3. Handle follow-up work
	<ul> <li>Capable to handle the following tasks:         <ul> <li>Ask the owners of the goods if he/she will submit a claim and how to handle the damaged goods</li> <li>Assist the owners of the goods with handling damaged goods, for example, destruction of goods or auctions. If the owners decide to return the goods, the practitioner needs to contact the shipper for returning the goods/handling the damaged goods.</li> <li>If the client is a carrier or insurance company, the practitioner needs to contact the client for instructions of handling the damaged goods.</li> <li>Complete survey reports</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
